

APPLICATION FORM FOR THE LICENSING OF BROADCASTING APPARATUS MCA/F/11-0578/R.1

Introduction

- 1. With regard to radiocommunications equipment, the Electronic Communications (Regulation) Act (Chapter 399 of the Laws of Malta)¹ provides that an individual licence is only required for the installation or use of equipment, unless the equipment is licence exempt or is regulated by a general authorisation. Noncompliance with this requirement is a breach of the said Act.
- 2. The radiocommunications licence to be issued under the said Act does not authorise the provision of electronic communications services / networks. Thus a separate authorisation is required for the provision of such services / networks².
- 3. The licence charges for the establishment and use of broadcasting apparatus are set out in paragraph 21 of the Fees leviable by Government Departments Regulations³. Please refer to Annex 1 for further information.
- 4. Radiocommunications apparatus falling within the scope of the Radio Equipment Regulations (S.L.427.41 of 2016)⁴ shall comply with the relevant provisions of the same Regulations.
- 5. Duly completed applications must be sent to the Malta Communications Authority (MCA) at the address indicated in this form. Incomplete applications will be returned to the applicant.
- 6. Any proposed or necessary changes to be effected to the system described in this application must be notified to the MCA with immediate effect.
- 7. Applicants may include any additional details in separate attachments.
- 8. The MCA shall act in accordance with the Data Protection Act (Cap. 440)⁵ when making use of any personal information that may be provided.

WARNING to all applicants - Any false statement, misinterpretation or concealment of material fact on this form or on any document presented in support of this application may be grounds for criminal prosecution.
