Denmark adopts new Data Retention Rules

The Danish Parliament adopted on 3 March 2022 a new data retention law. According to the minister of justice, the new rules, which have not yet entered into force, will bring the Danish data retention regime in line with the case law of the Court of Justice of the EU (CJEU).
