## Study shows Extensive Use of Existing Mobile Bands for 5G Deployment in EU

In 2019 the EU harmonised three 5G "pioneer bands": 700 MHz, 3.5 GHz and 26 GHz. Member states were meant to make these available by the end of 2020. However, there have been significant delays in assigning them, especially 26 GHz. The European Commission's 5G connectivity targets seem unlikely to be met as a result.
