BEREC consults on its Draft EU Wholesale Roaming Guidelines

BEREC, the assembly of European telecoms regulators, opened a public consultation on the proposed changes to its wholesale roaming guidelines. The guidelines deal with wholesale roaming access obligations for mobile network operators and the rights of access seekers. **Cullen International** (read more – subscription required)

UK Regulator to make License Changes to enable 5G Use

RSPG to consult soon on Updated Radio Spectrum Policy Programme for the EU

"Spectrum policy remains at the heart of reaching the digital targets the Commission has set," said Rita Wezenbeek, Director of DG CONNECT at the European Spectrum Management Conference in Brussels. "The European Union recently adopted 900 MHz and 1800 MHz harmonisation," said Wezenbeek. "This means that by 2023 we will have 21 GHz of harmonised spectrum for 5G in the EU." **Policy Tracker** (read more – subscription required)
