EU Radio Spectrum Policy Group consults on WRC-23 Opinion

The Radio Spectrum Policy Group has launched a consultation on its draft Opinion on the WRC-23 agenda items for ITU region 1. It doesn't take a firm position on lower UHF or upper 6 GHz bands, offering a number of options instead. **Policy Tracker** (read more – subscription required)

Belgium awards 5G Spectrum to Five Operators
