Ofcom consults on Net Neutrality

Ofcom, the UK telecoms regulator, is consulting on the review of its net neutrality guidance. Contrary to the EU ban on zero rating, Ofcom proposed to make it clear that most zero rating offers will continue to be allowed in the UK. **Cullen International** ([read more](#) – subscription required)

Revised Directive on Security of Network and Information Systems (NIS2): European Parliament endorses Final Agreement

The European Parliament (EP) endorsed on 10th November 2022 its provisional agreement with the Council of the EU on the revised directive on the security of network and information systems (NIS2). 577 members of the EP were in favour, six against and eight abstained. **Cullen International** ([read more](#) – subscription required)
