# EU and Western Balkans reciprocally Cap Retail Price for Mobile Roaming Data

The maximum retail price for international roaming data decreases to €18 per GB on 1<sup>st</sup> October 2023, according to a voluntary agreement between 38 European Union and Western Balkan operators. #### ANCOM adopts New Rules on the Use of Spectrum

The Romanian telecoms regulator, ANCOM, informed on 21<sup>st</sup> August 2023, on its website, about new rules on spectrum sharing, following national consultation.
