Denmark proposes to remove USO for most Letters and Parcels

Poland introduces Mandatory Public eDelivery Services

Electronic delivery will become mandatory in Poland for certain user groups on 10th December 2023. The Minister of Digitisation set the date in his announcement of 29th May 2023, as required by the Act on Electronic delivery and hybrid mail services of 18th November 2020, in force since 5th October 2021. **Cullen International** (read more – subscription required)
