DEVELOPMENTS IN ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATIONS NETWORK AND SERVICES

Spain - CNMC deregulates Wholesale Broadband Access Markets

The Spanish regulator, CNMC, decided that the wholesale local and central access markets (market 1/2020 and market 3b/2014) no longer meet the three cumulative criteria justifying the imposition of ex ante regulation. Existing obligations will be rolled back during a period of six months. **Cullen International** ([read more](#) – subscription required)

UK - Ofcom to set Fixed and Mobile Termination Rates for the Next Five Years

Ofcom proposed a cap of £0.000365 (0.04 € cents) per minute for fixed and £0.00487 (0.57 €cents) per minute for mobile call termination. The price caps would remain the same throughout the entire review period 2026–2031, without adjusting them for inflation (in contrast to the previous period 2021–2026). **Cullen International** ([read more](#) – subscription required)

Sweden proposes to reduce Quality of Service Obligations for Letter Delivery

The Swedish Ministry of Finance has proposed a draft amendment to the Postal Ordinance which would allow most domestic letters to be delivered within three working days of sending (D+3), instead of the current two working days (D+2). **Cullen International** ([read more](#) – subscription required)
